CLASS PROJECT

As part of the Leadership Pickens County experience, each class is required to complete a community service project, which should be implemented by April 30, 2024. The class will seat a small committee that will meet with the LPC Board of Regents to present an overview of your proposed class project. This presentation takes place on November 9, 2023. While the project committee will coordinate the process to research, identify, and organize the project, it is expected that ALL class members will be involved with identifying the project, as well as implementing the project.

During some of the full-day sessions, the agenda will allow for discussion related to your class project. However, in order to successfully develop and implement your class project, you will most likely need to schedule meetings outside the time frame of the scheduled follow-up sessions. The scope and timeline of the class project will determine the number and frequency of these extra meetings. The class members will collectively decide how to plan and manage these meetings.
