CLASS PROJECT

As part of the Leadership Pickens County experience, each class is required to complete a community service project, which should be implemented by April 30, 2025. At the Class Retreat, the class will seat committees to effectively manage & execute the project. However, EVERY class member is required to be actively engaged in identifying the project, as well as implementing the project. To get the project started on a firm path, a small group of class members will meet with the LPC Board of Regents to present an overview of your proposed class project. This presentation takes place on November 14, 2024.

During some of the full-day sessions, the agenda will allow for discussion related to your class project. However, in order to successfully develop and implement your class project, you will most likely need to schedule meetings outside the time frame of the scheduled follow-up sessions. The scope and timeline of the class project will determine the number and frequency of these extra meetings. The class members will collectively decide how to plan and manage these meetings.



Code of Conduct

As current and future leaders, Leadership Pickens County class members are stewards of our community so it's imperative that our LPC participants always display the highest level of professionalism and accountability. With this objective in mind, a "Code of Conduct" has been developed which all participants are expected to follow.

I will arrive on time for each session, recognizing the need to stay on schedule to complete the full session agenda.

I will participate in the class sessions using the group transportation provided. The Chamber must be notified in advance of any plans that a class member will not travel with the group for a particular session.

I will give session speakers my full attention. Class noise and/or side-bar conversations not only cause distractions, but also foster a sense of disrespect for our speakers' time and expertise.

I will silence my cell phone and will not check messages, return calls, or browse the internet during speaker presentations. Other than an emergency situation, ALL of my cell phone usage should be limited to scheduled breaks and lunch. Cell phones create distractions for other class members, as well as speakers who have graciously donated their time and expertise. LPC understands unexpected situations arise that require attention; however, these situations should be rare in occurrence.

I will demonstrate a respectful attitude in expressing my opinions and listening to others. Differences of opinion can sometimes become more disruptive and argumentative than objective and diplomatic. Effective leadership evaluates all sides of the issue before reaching an agreeable solution.

I will make every attempt to attend every class session, and if unable to attend, I will notify the chamber in advance of the session.

I am expected to comply with the agenda and instructions given by the session facilitators.

I will participate in the class sessions for the full agenda time. Leaving & re-entering a session should take place only during the scheduled session breaks and lunch periods. In addition, I understand that absence from any portion of a session will be counted as a full session absence (i.e. arriving late, leaving & returning during the day, or leaving the session prior to the scheduled adjournment), unless prior approval has been given. Class members will be required to sign-in and sign-out of each session to confirm their attendance.

I understand that participation in the class retreat is mandatory. Other than the class retreat, there is a total of two (2) full days of absent time allowed from the full-day sessions. I understand that absence from any portion of a session will be counted as a session absence (i.e. arriving late, leaving & returning during the day, or leaving the session prior to the scheduled adjournment). Participants and their sponsoring employer will be notified in writing of each session absence. Exceeding the total of allowable absence time will result in failure to be eligible for graduation. No tuition refunds will be issued due to excessive absences or failure to graduate.

I understand there is a requirement to actively participate in the successful implementation of the class community service project. Failure to uphold this expectation not only compromises the cohesiveness of the LPC class, but potentially lessens the impact the class project will have on our community.
